### **SHORT TERM CONSULTANCY: ENSURING HUMAN RIGHTS AND GENDER ARE MAINSTREAMED IN THE GF GRANT (2021-2023) FOR KENYA**

#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

The Stop TB Partnership Kenya (STP – Kenya) is a movement of individuals and organizations from Government of Kenya, business and corporate community, patient community and the people of Kenya working towards elimination of TB and reduction of poverty-related diseases in Kenya.

In line with the global commitments and targets on TB, Stop TB Partnership- Kenya advocates for protection of human rights of those infected with TB and gender mainstreamed programming in ensuring everyone is reached with TB services.

In this view, stop TB partnership- Kenya is looking for a qualified consultant to ensure Human rights and gender are mainstreamed throughout the process of development of the Global Fund grant from the concept note development through the granting process up to the implementation level. S/He will also ensure a patient centred approach in the TB programming in the GF grant interventions and the entire TB response in Kenya in line with the National strategic plan.

#### **Details of the assignment**

The Consultant will build the capacities of selected TB advocate and champions in TB communities, human rights and gender (CRG) provisions in GF grant as identified in the communities, gender and human rights assessment report in Kenya. The consultant will engage the advocates in the granting process to identify and ensure CRG issues are retained in the GF grant up to the implementation phase and be able to engage in community based monitoring on the same issues throughout the grant.

#### **Scope of Work**

1. Compile the Human right and gender provisions for the GF grant, from the CRG country reports and other relevant tools.
2. Develop a tool for sensitizing TB advocates and champions on CRG requirements in the GF grant.

3. Sensitize the TB advocates and champions on CRG requirements for GF grant as provided by GF.
4. Develop a checklist to monitor CRG mainstreaming in the grant to be used by the TB Advocates and champions.
5. Assign the sensitized TB advocates and champions to the various modules to monitor and ensure Human rights, Gender and the young people) are well integrated in the entire process including the implementation.
6. Develop a detailed report for submission to Stop TB and the donor.

### **Deliverables**

- ❖ A sensitization curriculum for sensitizing TB champions and advocates on Human rights, gender and issues of young people in TB grant and programming.
- ❖ A presentation of the provision of Human rights, gender and young people in TB GF grant and implementation.
- ❖ A checklist for monitoring CRG mainstreaming in the GF granting process and implementation.
- ❖ A report to STOP TB and to the Donor.

### **Qualification & Experience**

- A Post Graduate Degree in Public Health, Law, Social Sciences or equivalent.
- At least 5 years' experience in TB programming, gender and Human rights.
- Demonstrated technical expertise and hands-on experience working with Civil Society and TB infected communities.
- Experience in working in human rights.
